On the last day of February, Tirana was the focal point for Western Balkans leaders and EU Commissioner Oliver Várhelyi to discuss the region's economic enhancement through the <u>EU's Growth Plan</u>. The plan aims for closer integration with the EU's single market, spotlighting initiatives like SEPA for fee-free transactions, Green Lanes 2.0 for smoother trade, Wifi4WB to

expand internet access, and Digital Innovation Hubs to boost digital skills.

Earlier in January, President Ursula von der Leyen, alongside Prime Ministers Mark Rutte and Andrej Plenković, visited Sarajevo to support Bosnia and Herzegovina's EU accession path, following the EU's readiness for opening negotiations once the criteria are met in December 2023. They engaged with key officials and held a press conference with Chairwoman Borjana Krišto, aiming to align the country more closely with EU standards, and concluded with meetings highlighting the EU's commitment to integration.

Additionally, the European Commission and Montenegro in January signed an agreement allowing Montenegro to enter the <u>EU4Health programme</u>, enhancing Montenegro's health system's capacity for immediate and long-term healthcare needs. This agreement enables Montenegro to access EU funding, joining others in the region in health system strengthening.
