A significant milestone was achieved for the Western Balkans with the European Parliament and member states reaching a political agreement on the Growth Plan, committing a record €6 billion to aid Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, Montenegro, North Macedonia, and Serbia in their integration into the European Union. This agreement not only promises

financial assistance but also demands rigorous reforms and governance improvements from the Western Balkans, ensuring a mutual effort towards a more rapid and efficient accession process.

The European Commission honored mayors from the Western Balkans and Türkiye with the "Most Roma Friendly Mayor" awards, recognizing their exemplary dedication to championing the rights and inclusion of Roma communities. Presented by Valentina Superti, Director for the Western Balkans at the European Commission's DG Neighbourhood and Enlargement, the awards underscored the crucial role of local leaders in advocating for equality and enhancing social inclusion.
