#EUandYOU

Albania and North Macedonia held the last <u>screening meetings</u> where they presented their level of alignment with EU rules and policies and their preparedness to implementing the remaining parts and fulfil the criteria for EU membership. Screening represents the first step in the accession negotiations process.

In the meantime, the <u>European Council announced</u> it will open accession negotiations with Bosnia and Herzegovina once the country has achieved the necessary degree of compliance with the membership criteria.

The European Commission also announced an additional €680 million investment package for the Western Balkans under the Economic and Investment Plan to support <u>five flagship investments</u>.
