



The "#EUandYOU – Together it's possible" campaign was launched mid-November across the Western Balkan region. The campaign aims to raise awareness about the themes and flagship projects that are part of the EU Economic and Investment Plan (EIP) for the region. This is the second <u>regional communication campaign</u> under the EU Regional Communication Programme for the Western Balkans – <u>WeBalkans.eu</u>.

The EIP puts forward almost €30 billion of funding and investments in the areas of green and digital transitions, connectivity and growth. This unprecedented support aims to help the region emerge stronger from the pandemic, unlock opportunities for future growth, and bring the region closer to the EU.
