## **YEAs sign-off on the most successful year so far!**

Young European Ambassadors (YEAs) from the Western Balkans are signing-off to 2022 as the most successful year so far. With over a hundred activities including live events and



street actions, from study trips to institutional engagement, and from online meetings and social media campaigns, YEAs have confirmed they are the real deal to show leadership as future decision makers in the region. YEAs showed incredible initiative by co-organised events with as many as 40 partners from all levels, and over 50 actions with the EU Delegations in the region with over 600 participants.

The WeBalkans started the network with 60 YEAs in 2020, grew to 120 a year later and had 180 involved during 2022 making it one of the largest and most diverse youth networks in the Western Balkans region.
