



The <u>EU Energy Support Package for the Western Balkans</u> is being disbursed as of February 2023. The €1 billion provided by the European Commission aims to help the region to better cope with the consequences of the energy crisis and improve the region's energy security.

The EU aid will focus especially on the most vulnerable households and on small and medium enterprises who will pay less for energy. The rest of the first part of the package provides direct funds to the region's economies through budget-support measures to support policy measures to accelerate the energy transition.

So far <u>Bosnia and Herzegovina</u> and <u>Serbia</u> have signed the budget support agreement with the EU, respectively for €70 million and €165 million.

The <u>second part of the package</u> worth €500 million, will cover investments to diversify energy supplies, boost renewable energy and energy efficiency. It will also promote the

clean energy transition of the region and cut dependency on Russia's fossil fuels.


Branded "Reinventing the Future", the event hosted nine speakers from the Western Balkans and the European Union.
