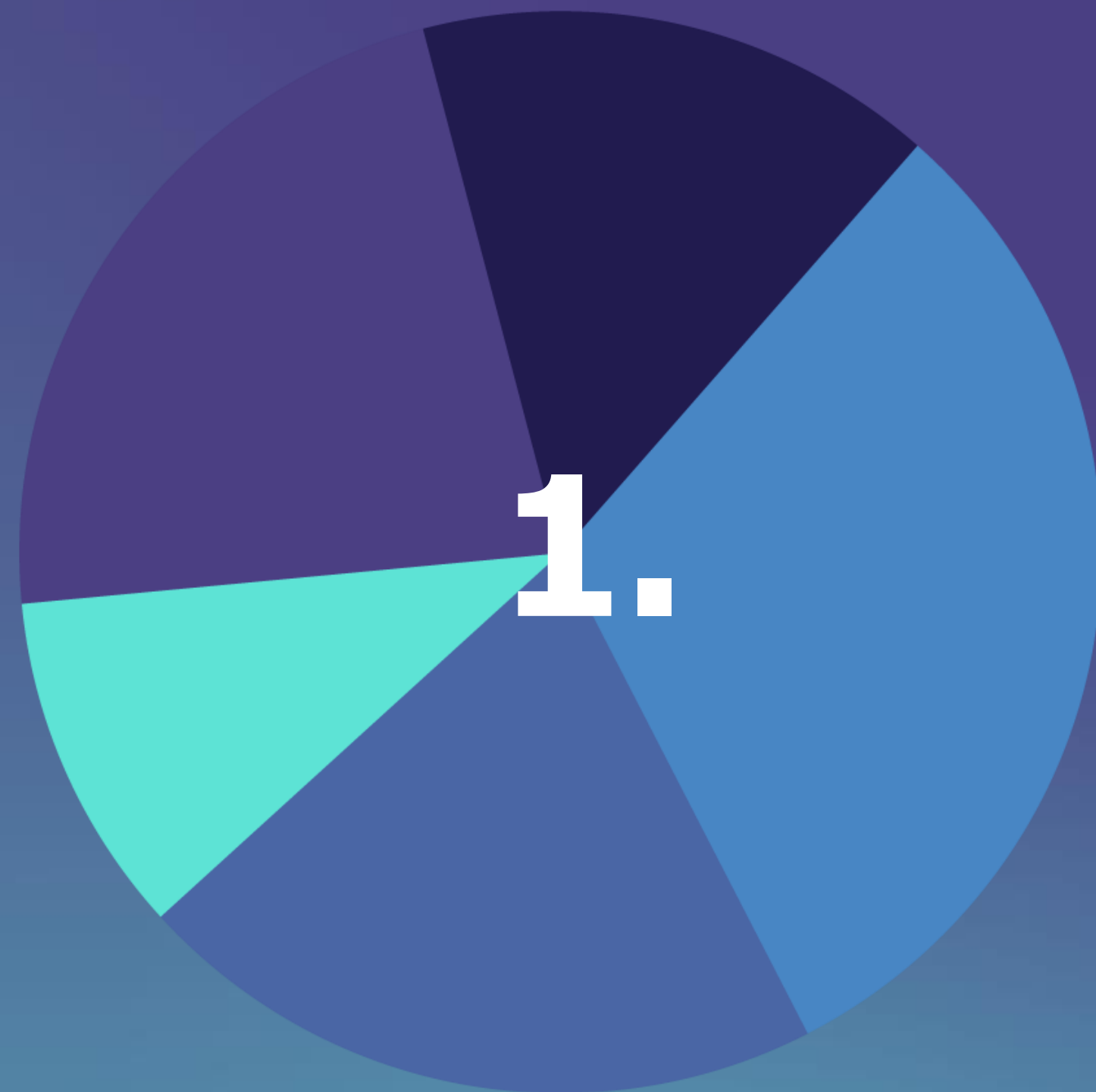
## METHODOLOGY

**Quantitative survey** targeting the general population in **Montenegro** aged 15+ and living in the country

**1005 respondents** randomly selected through a two-stage stratified sampling design with cities/towns/settlements as Primary Sampling Units (PSUs) & individuals as Secondary Sampling Units (SSUs)

**Face to face interviews** (field work) conducted in **May 2025** and covering the following topics:

- Information, awareness and perceptions of the EU
- EU relations with Montenegro and awareness of EU's financial support
- Agreement on common narratives
- Public perceptions of the EU accession: support, expectations and concerns
- Institutional trust and national challenges
- Source of news and information

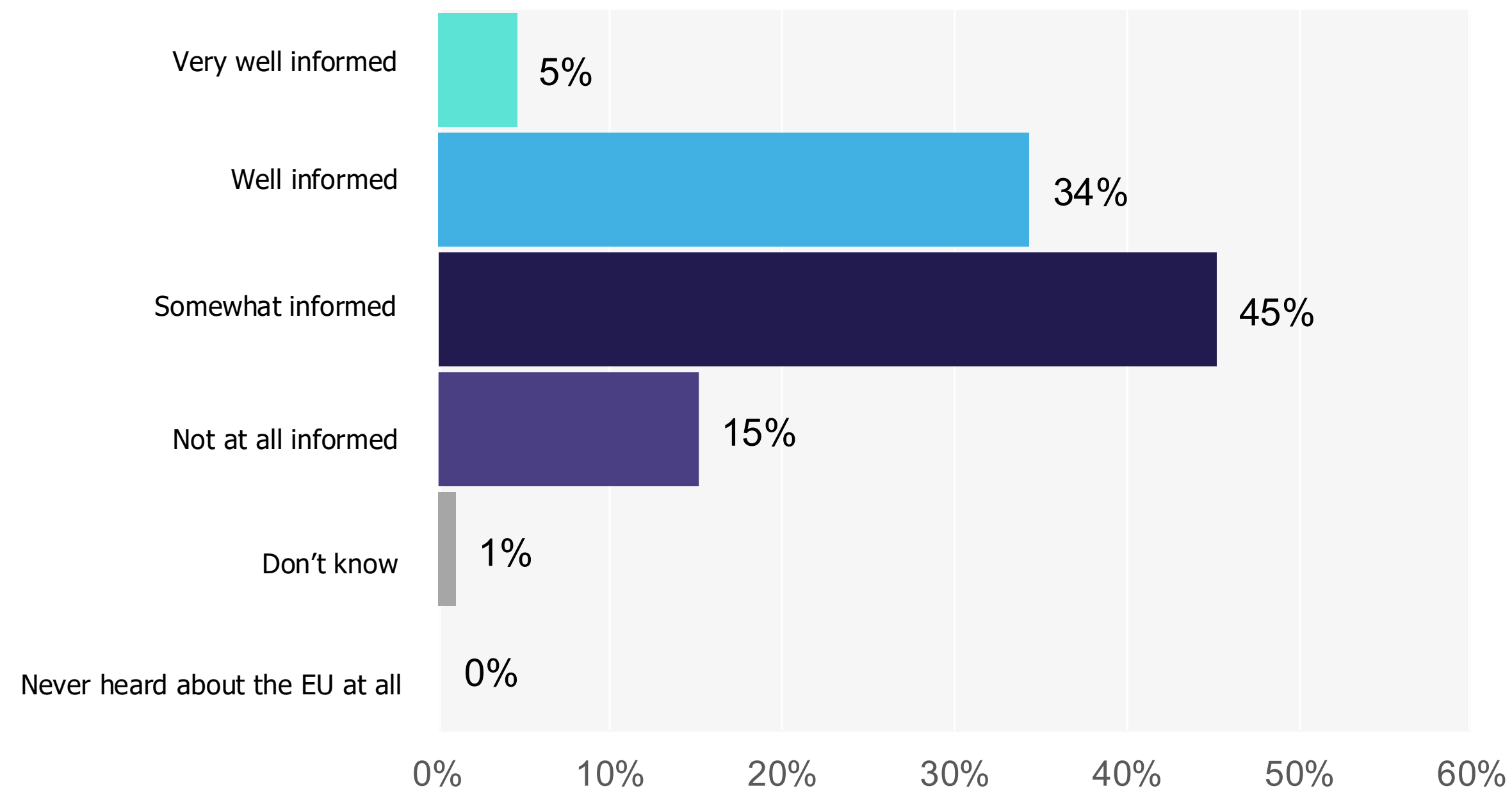

To what extent are you informed about the European Union?

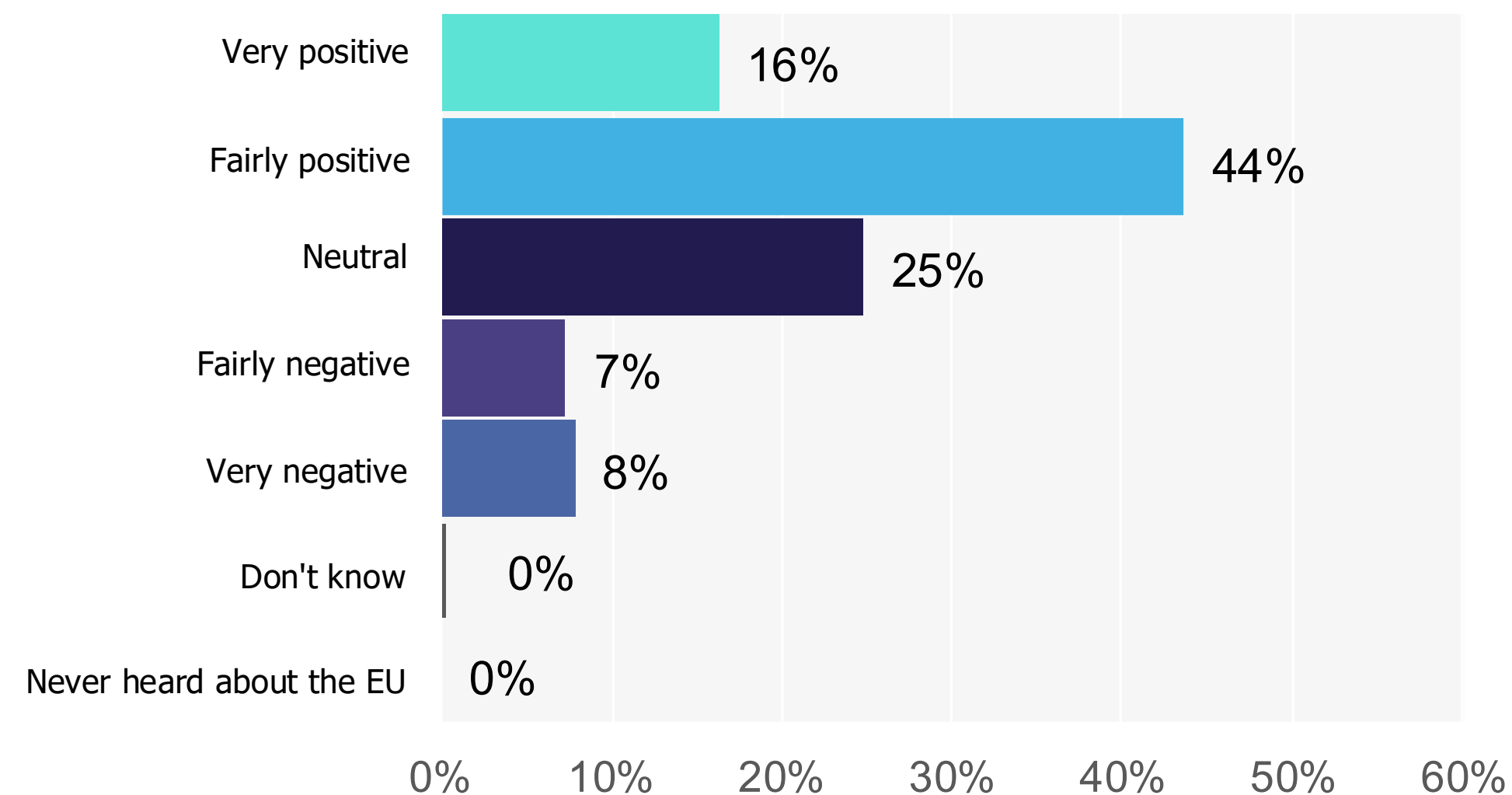


**39%**

Do you have a very positive, fairly positive, neutral, fairly negative or very negative image of the European Union?

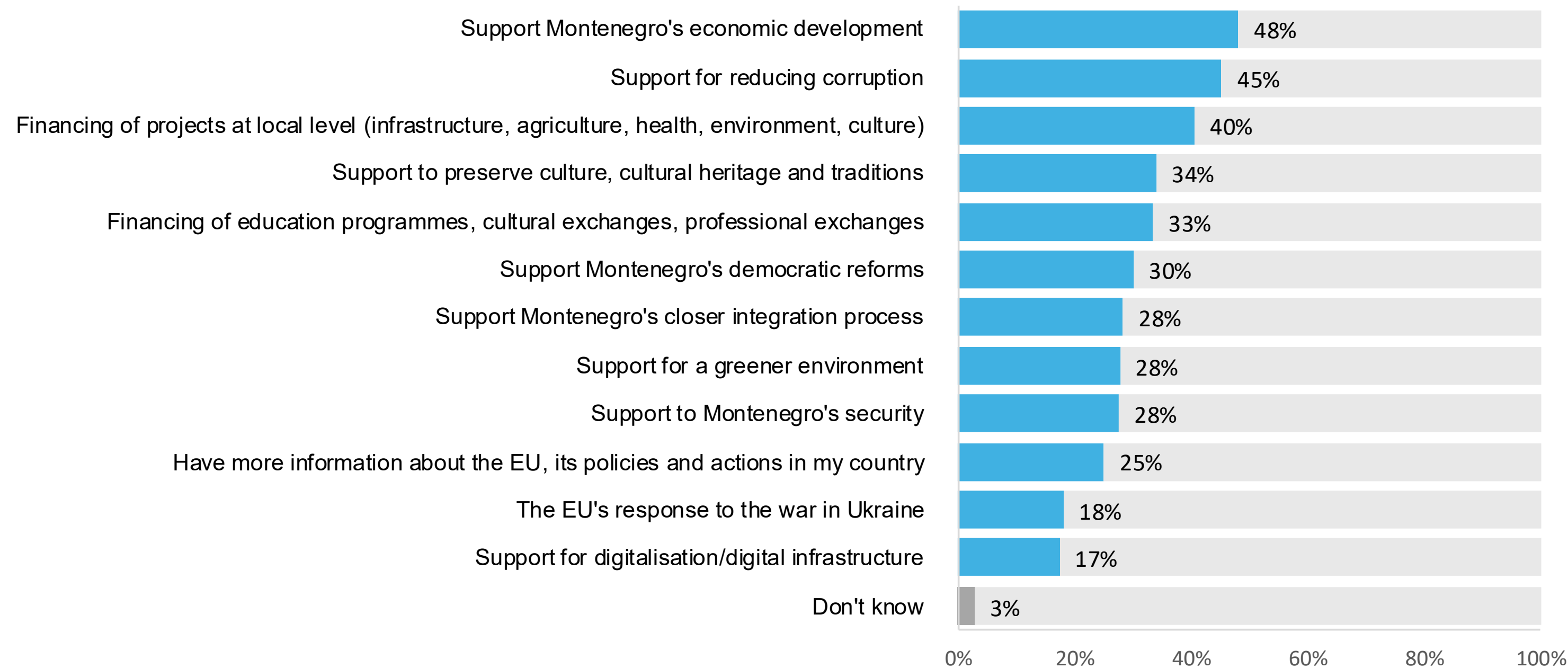
2025 image of the EU – detailed breakdown

The **most important factors** that have been more frequently indicated are the following:

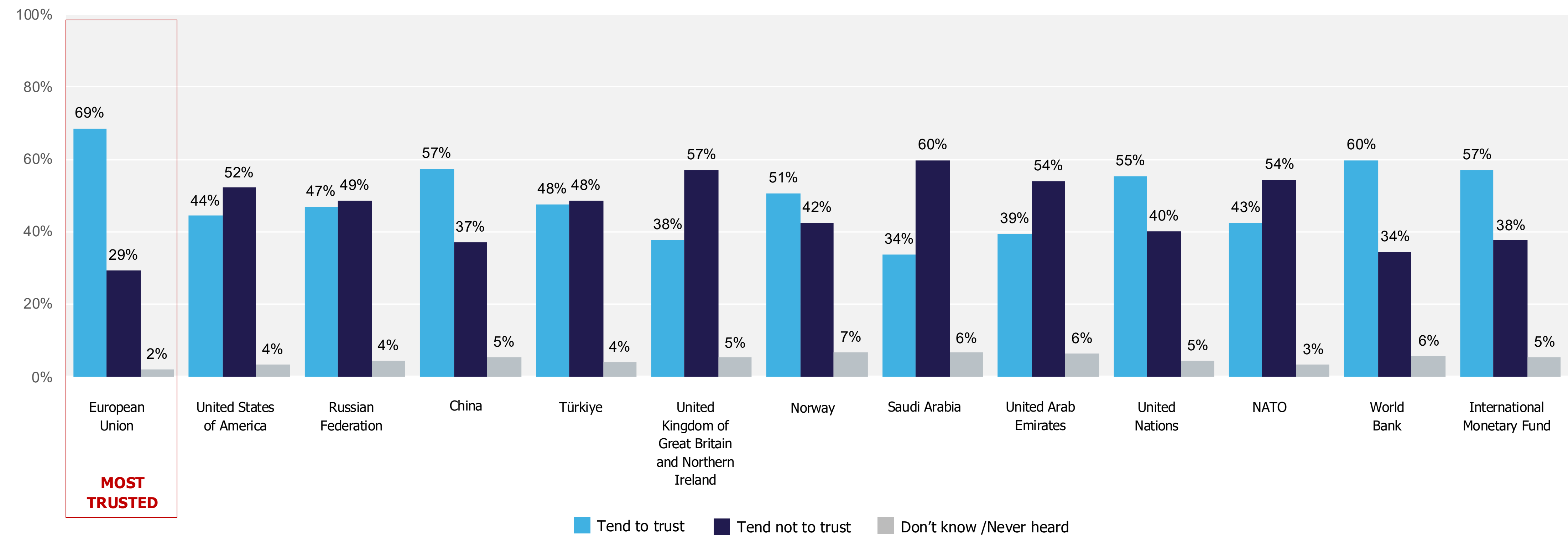
1. Support to Montenegro's economic development (23%)
2. Financing of projects at local level (infrastructure, agriculture, health, environment, culture) (15%)
3. Support for reducing corruption (5%)

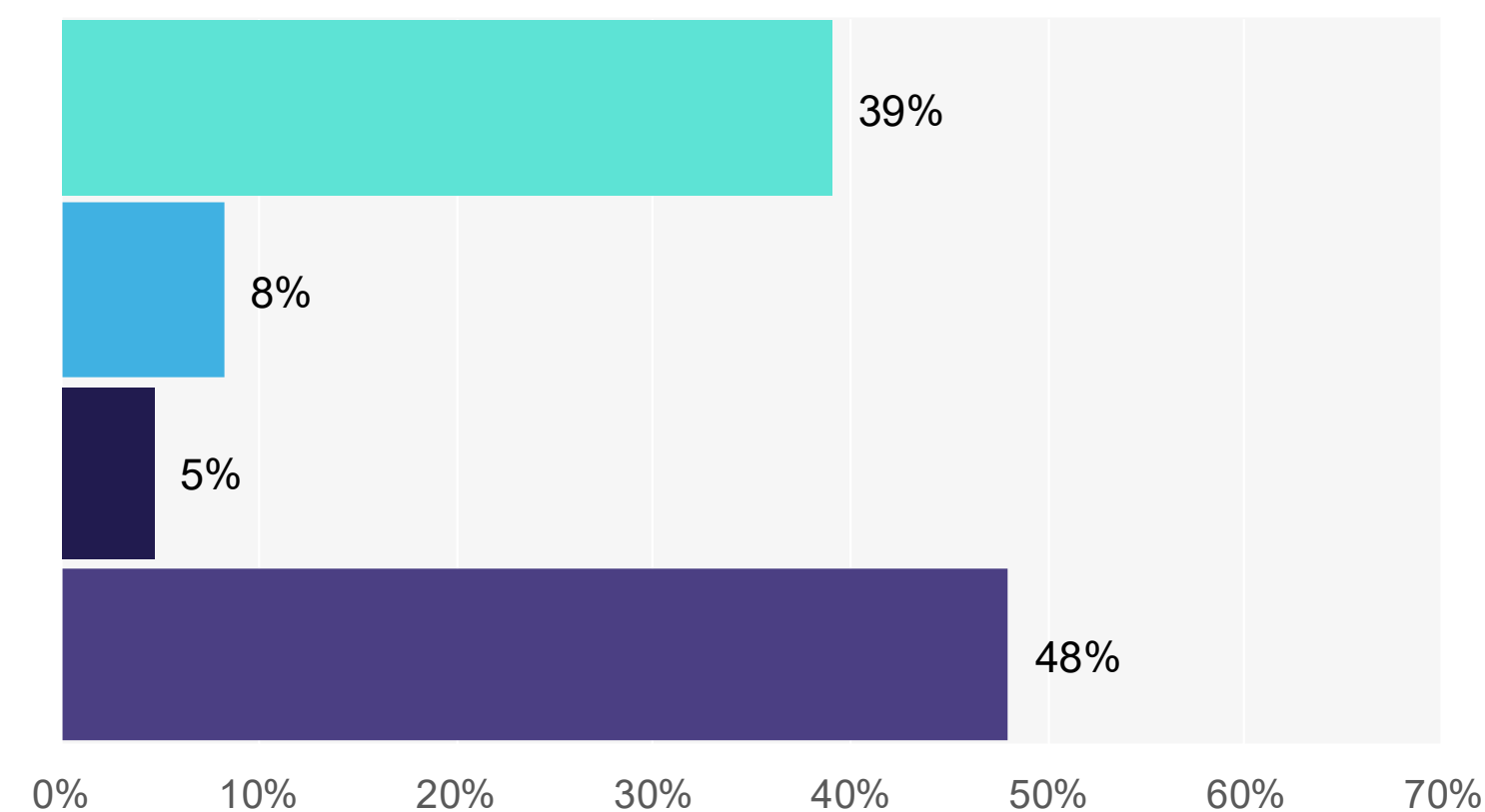

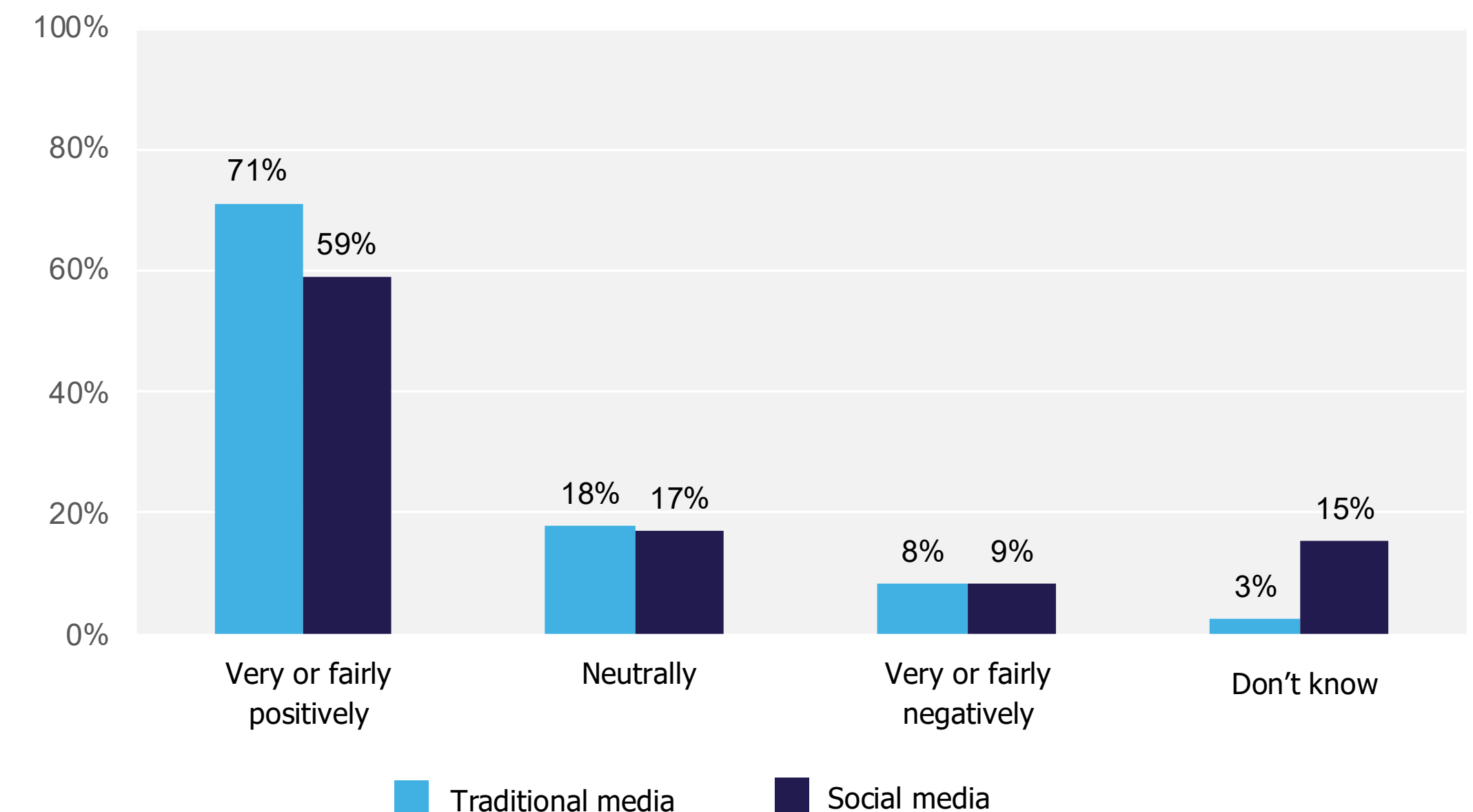

Have you read, seen or heard or looked for any information about the EU in the last three months?

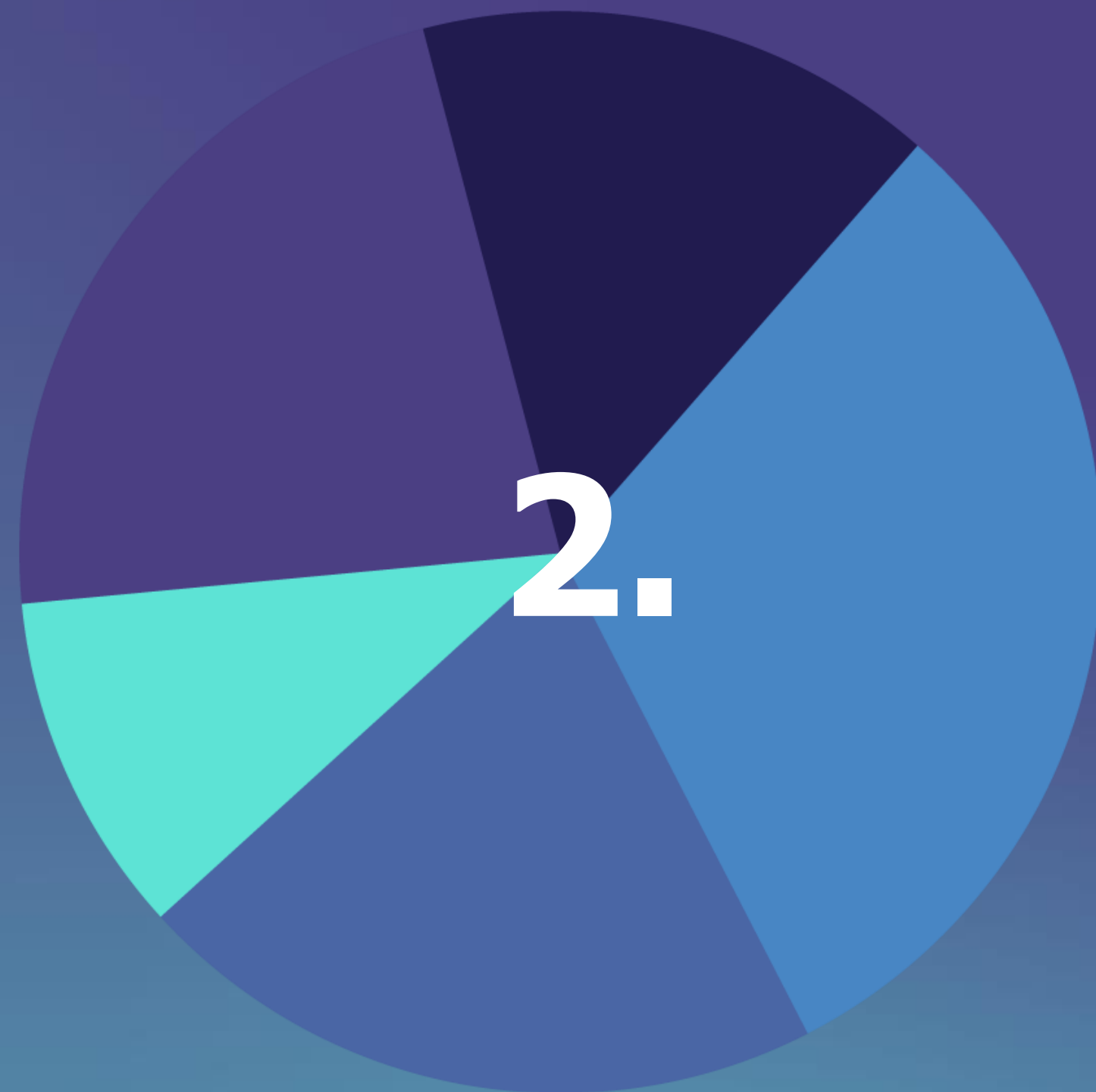

In general, how would you say the EU was presented in traditional media (i.e., television, radio and or newspaper) and In social media?





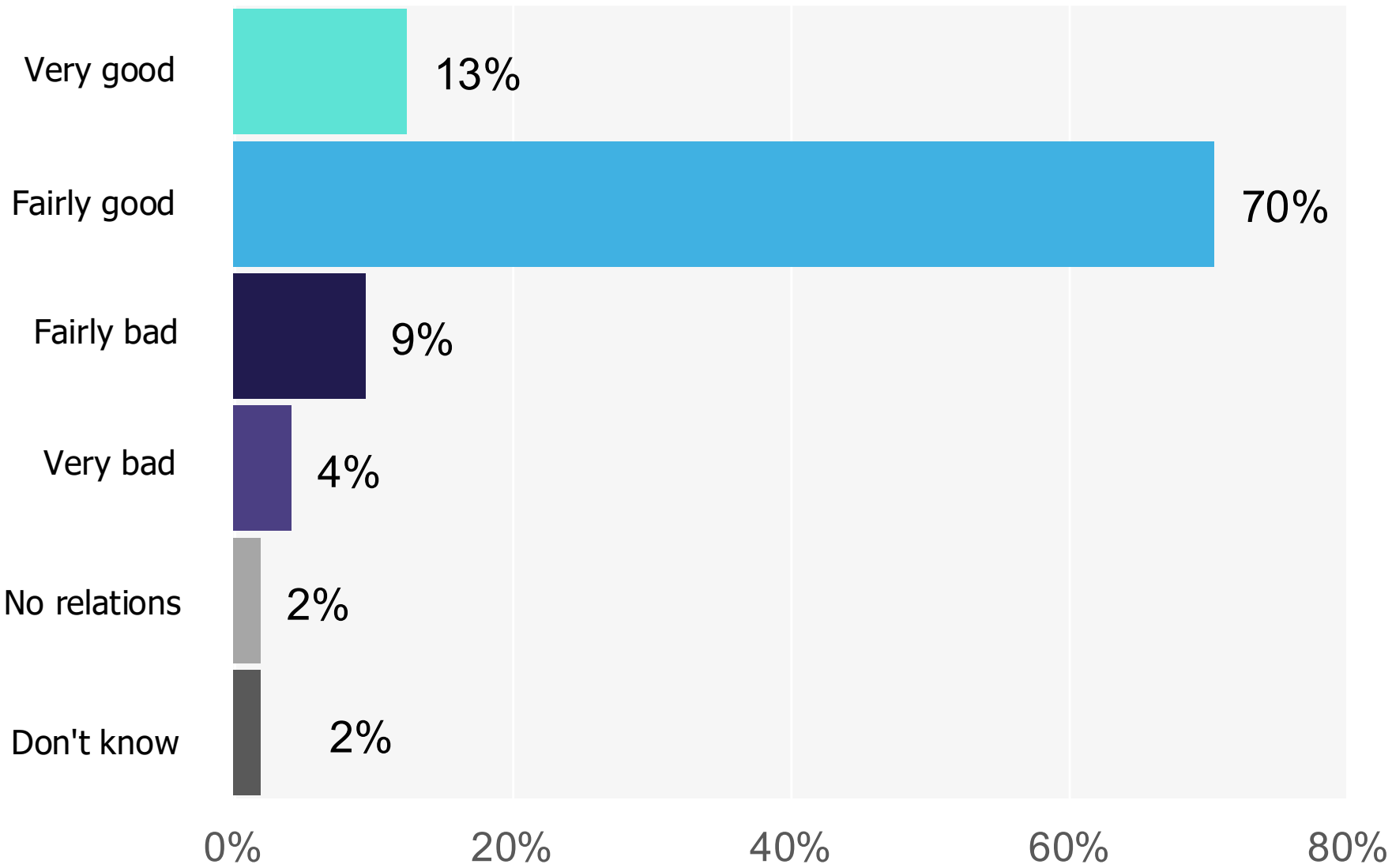

Would you describe them as very good, fairly good, fairly bad or very bad?

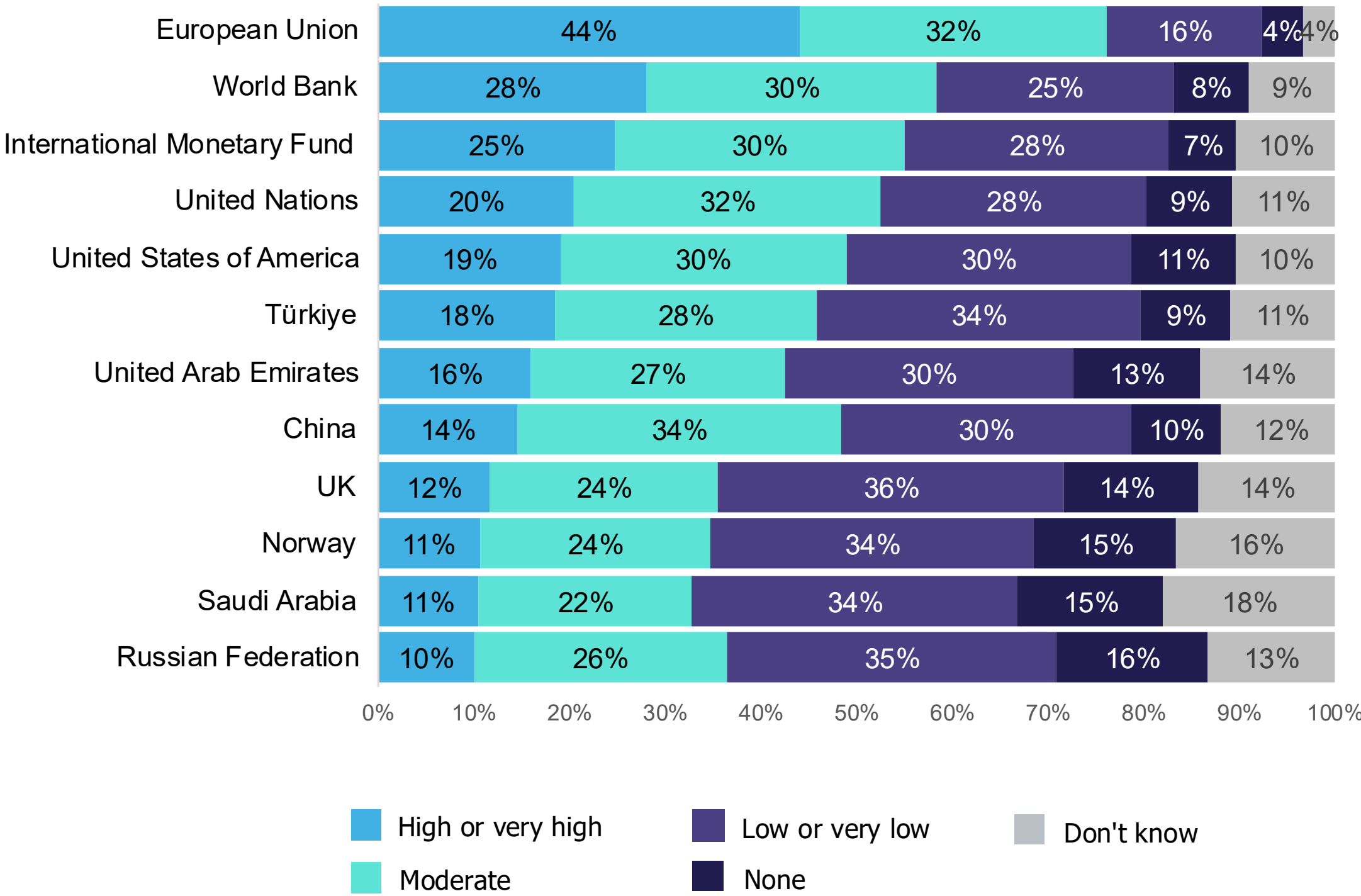

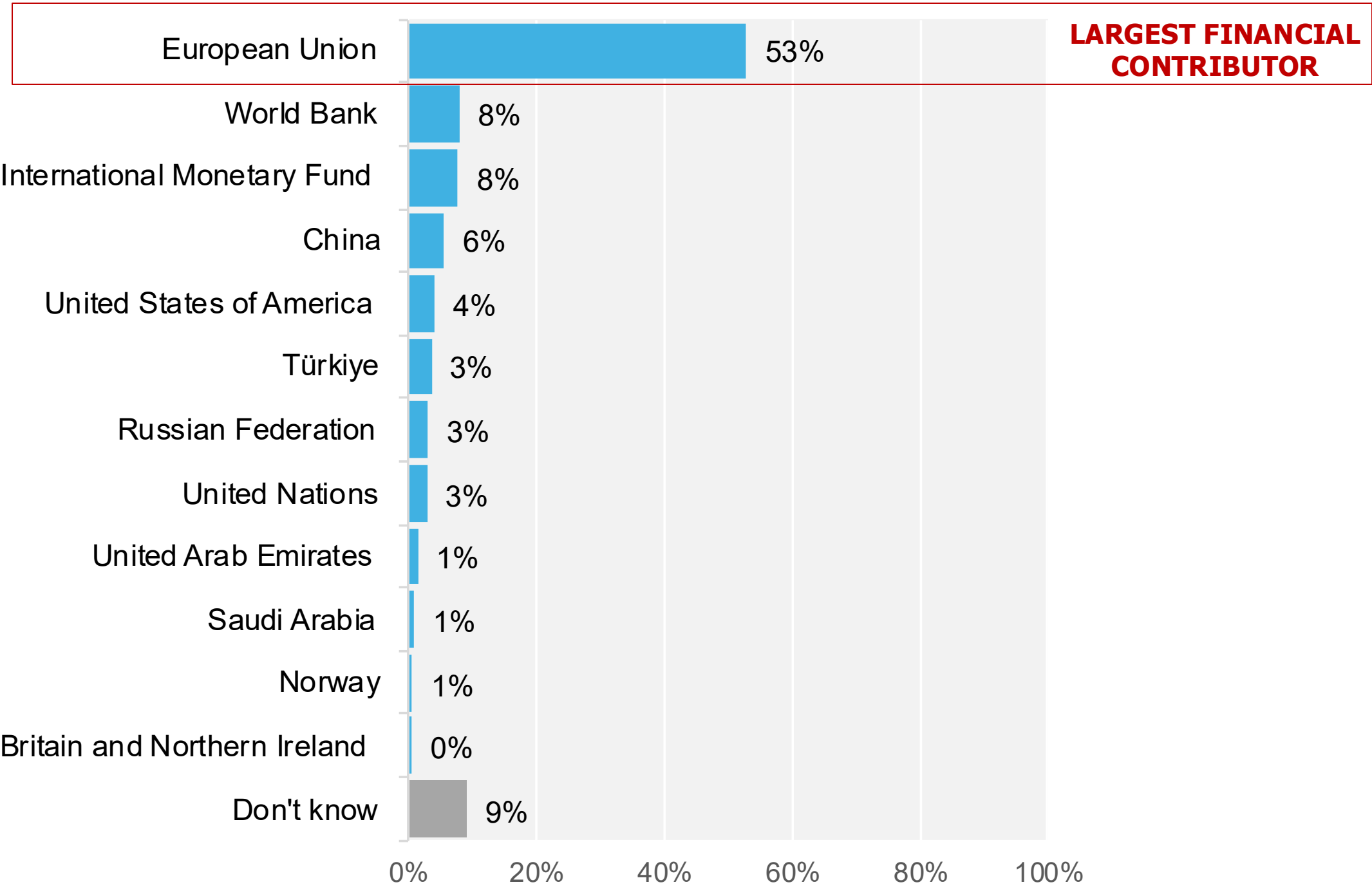

In your opinion, what is the level of financial support to Montenegro from each of the following?

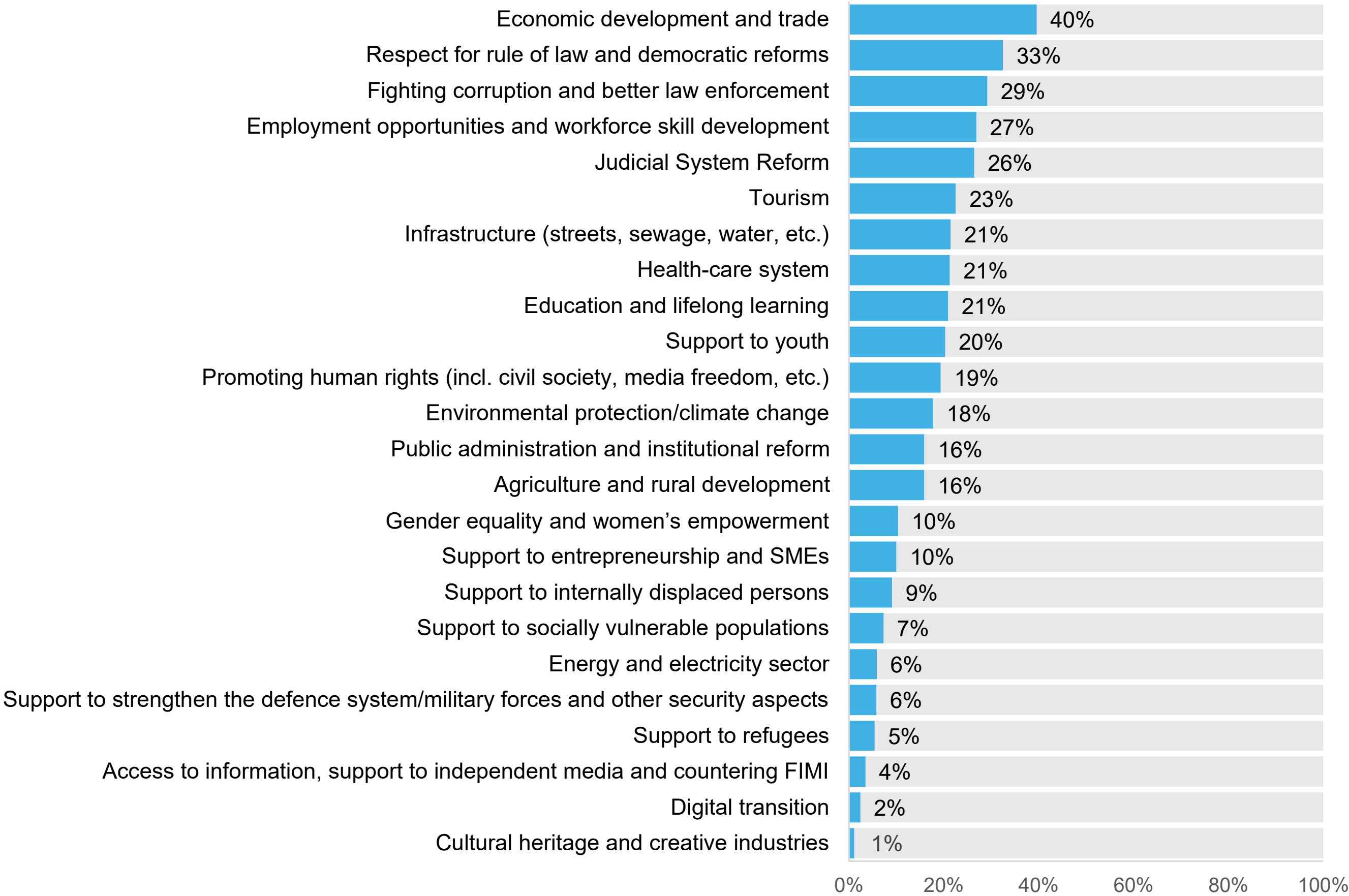


Which of these do you believe is the largest financial contributor to Montenegro?

Please tell us in which areas the European Union provides Montenegro with financial support

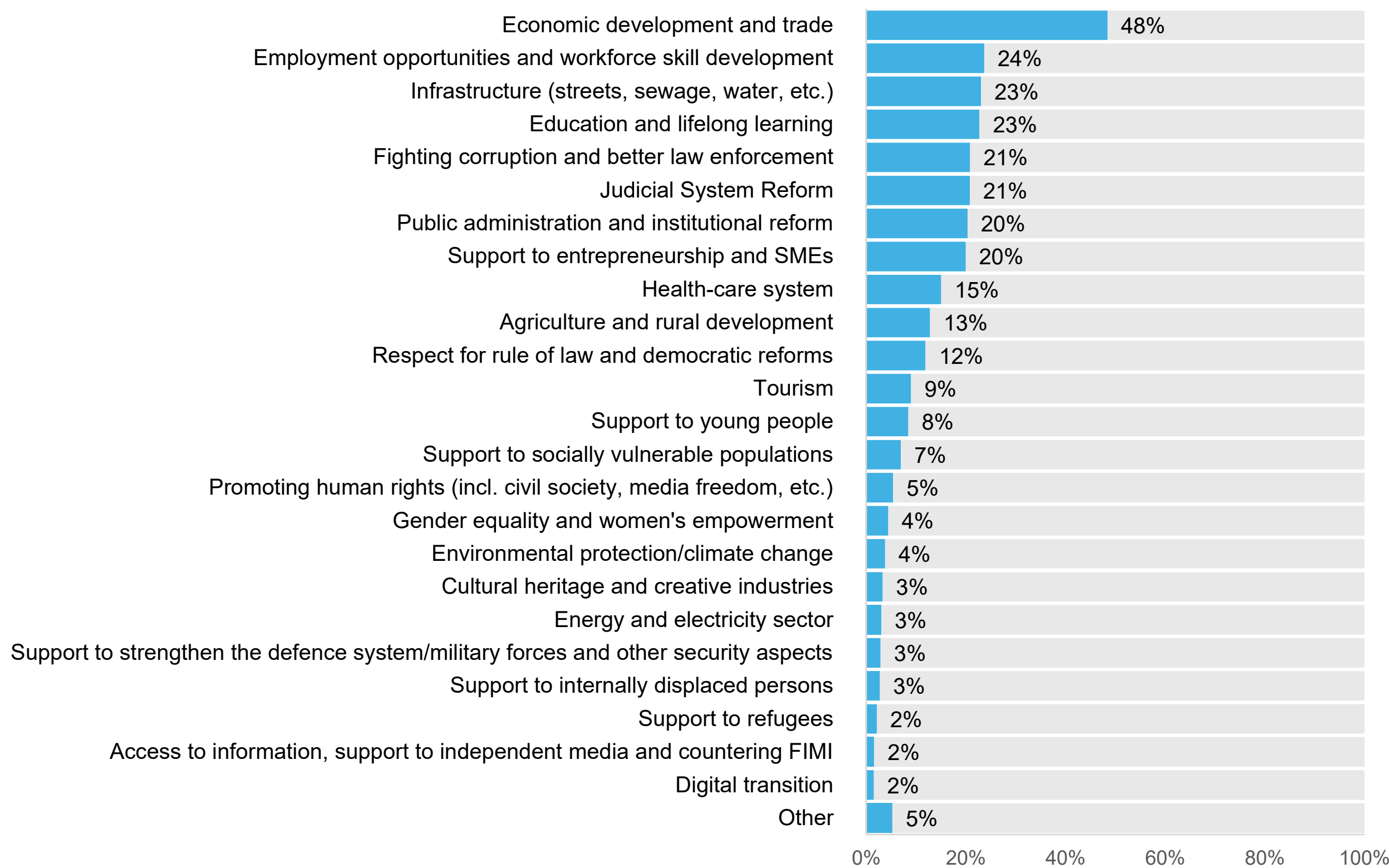

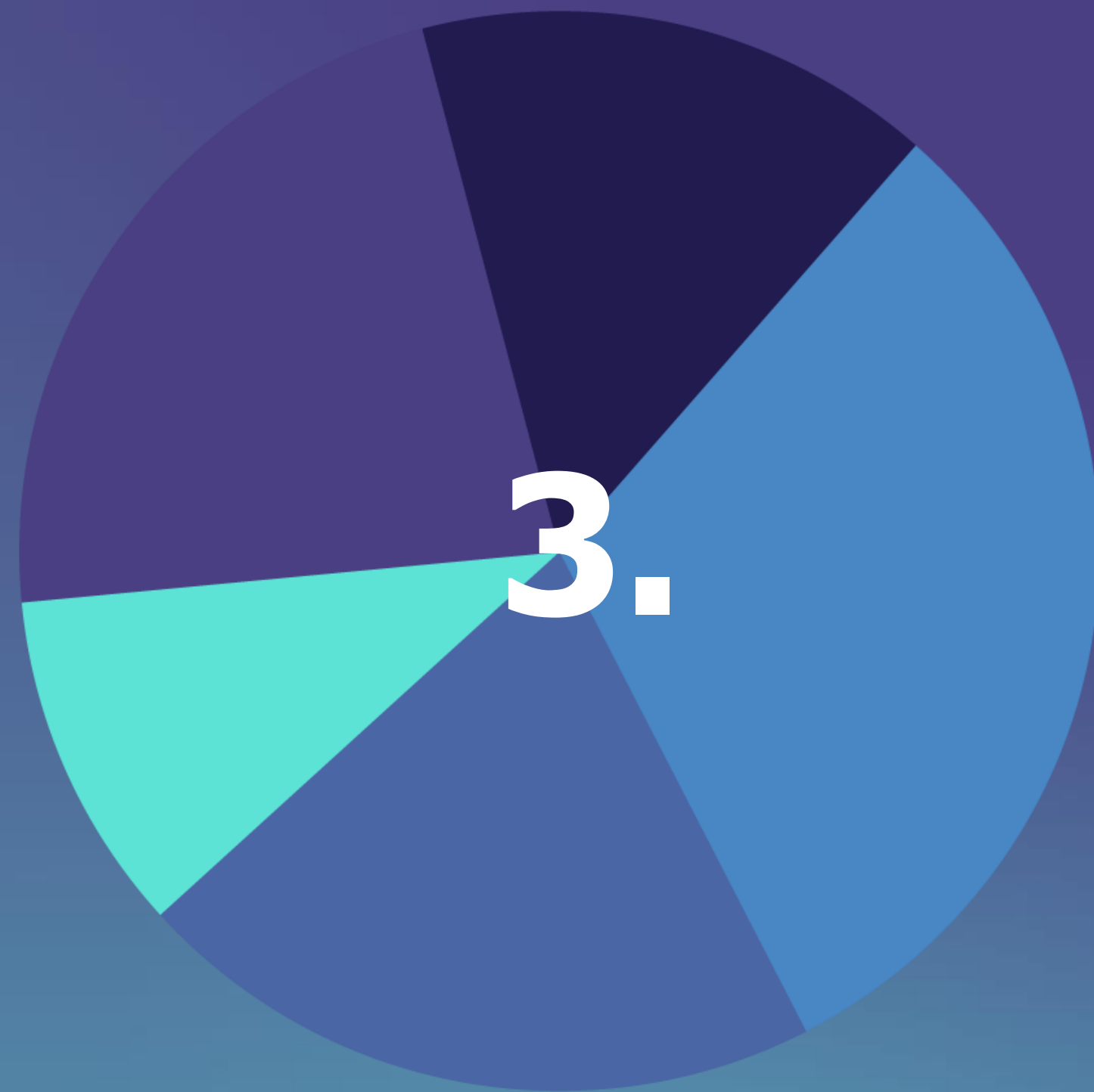
# EU's financial support

3. Education and lifelong learning (7%) and Fighting corruption and better law enforcement (7%)



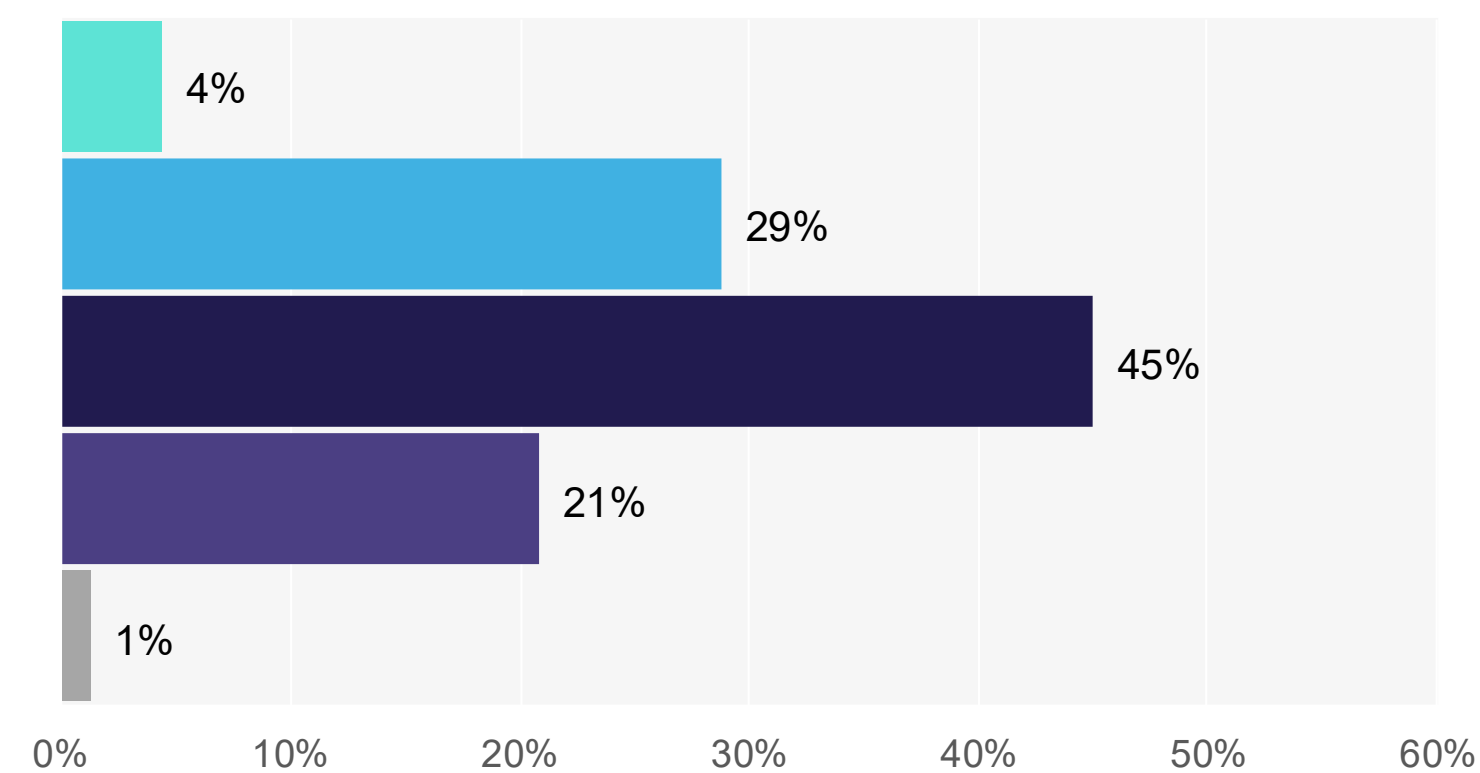

To what extent do you consider yourself well informed about Montenegro's process of integration into the EU ?

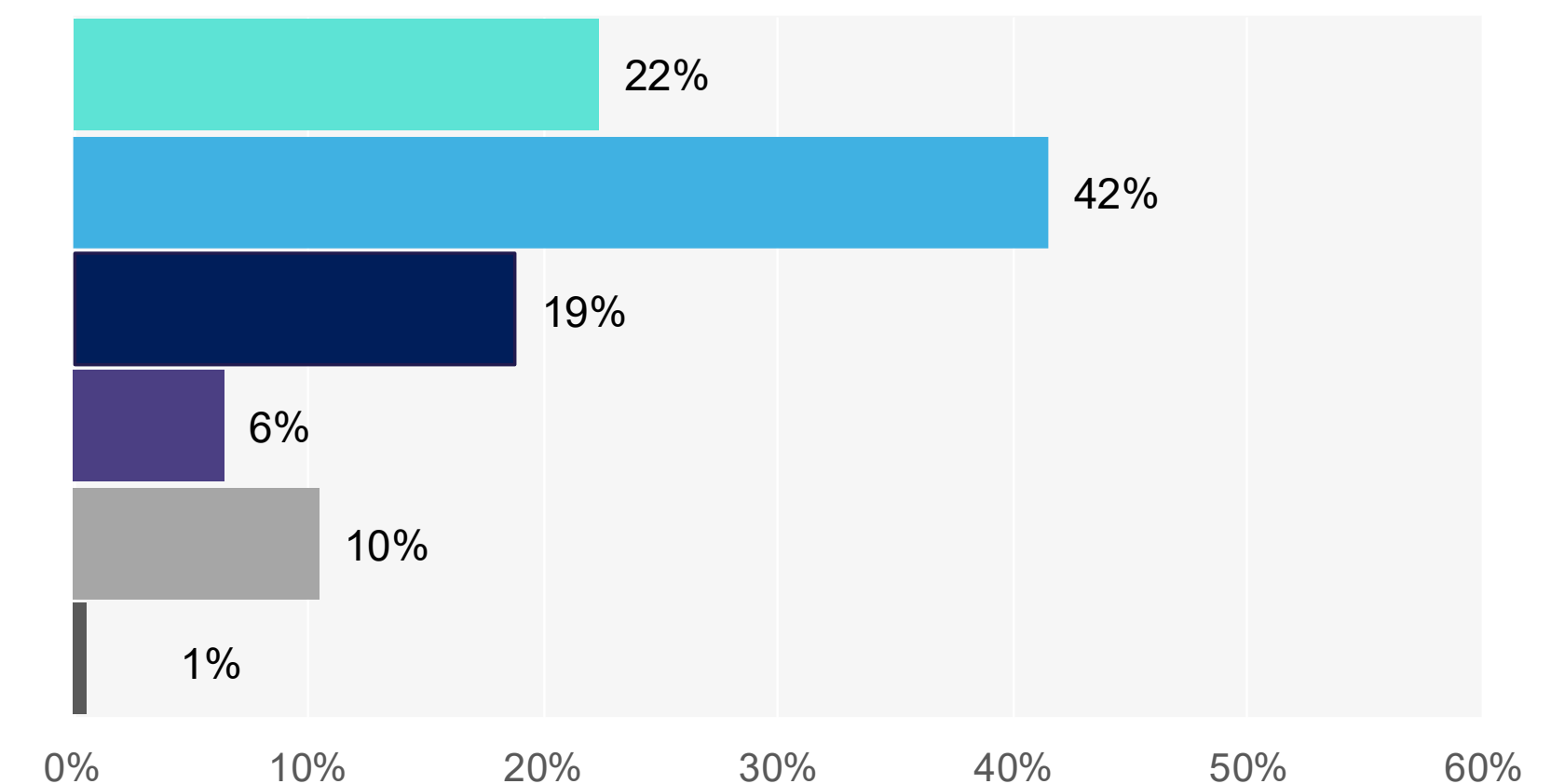

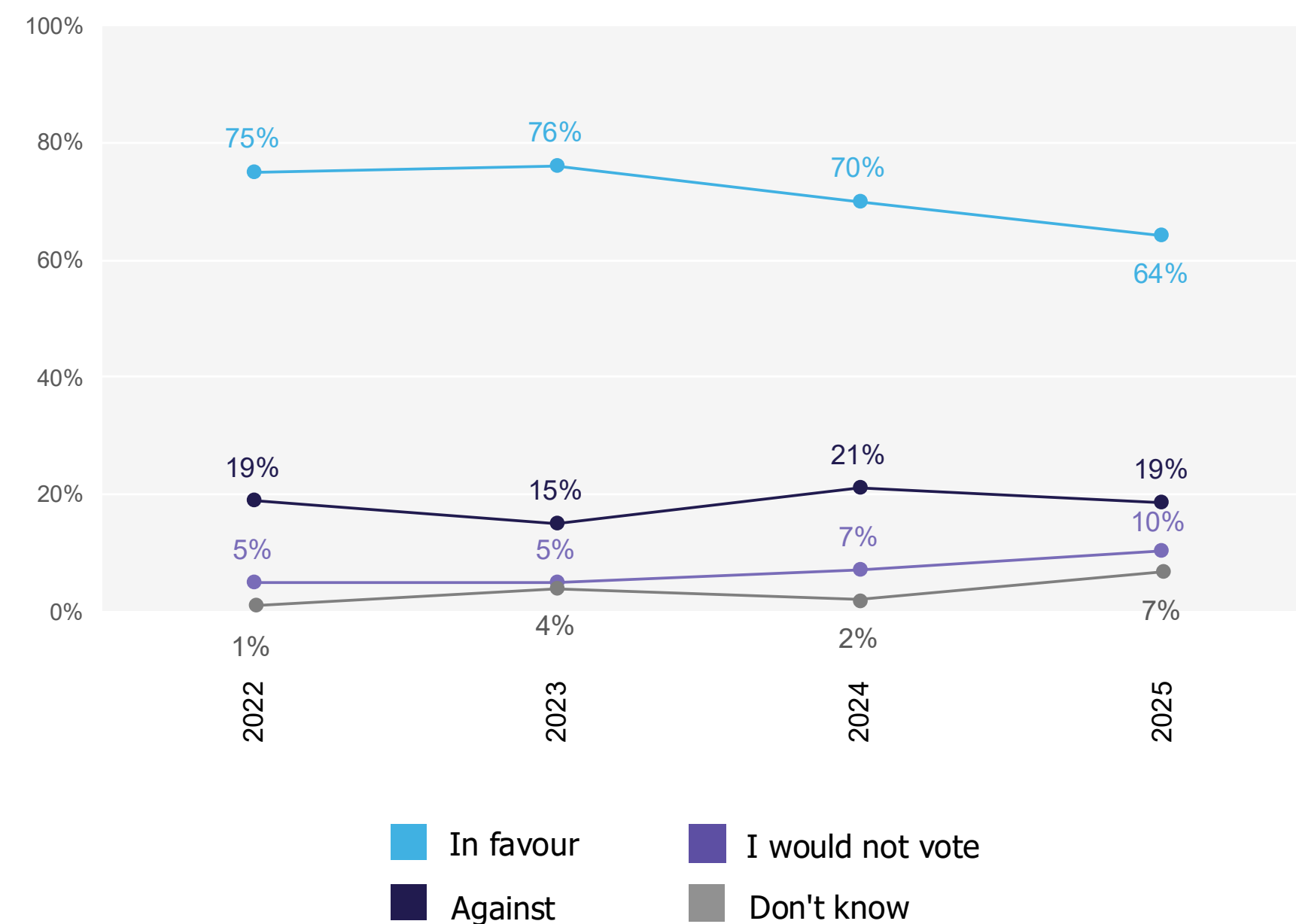

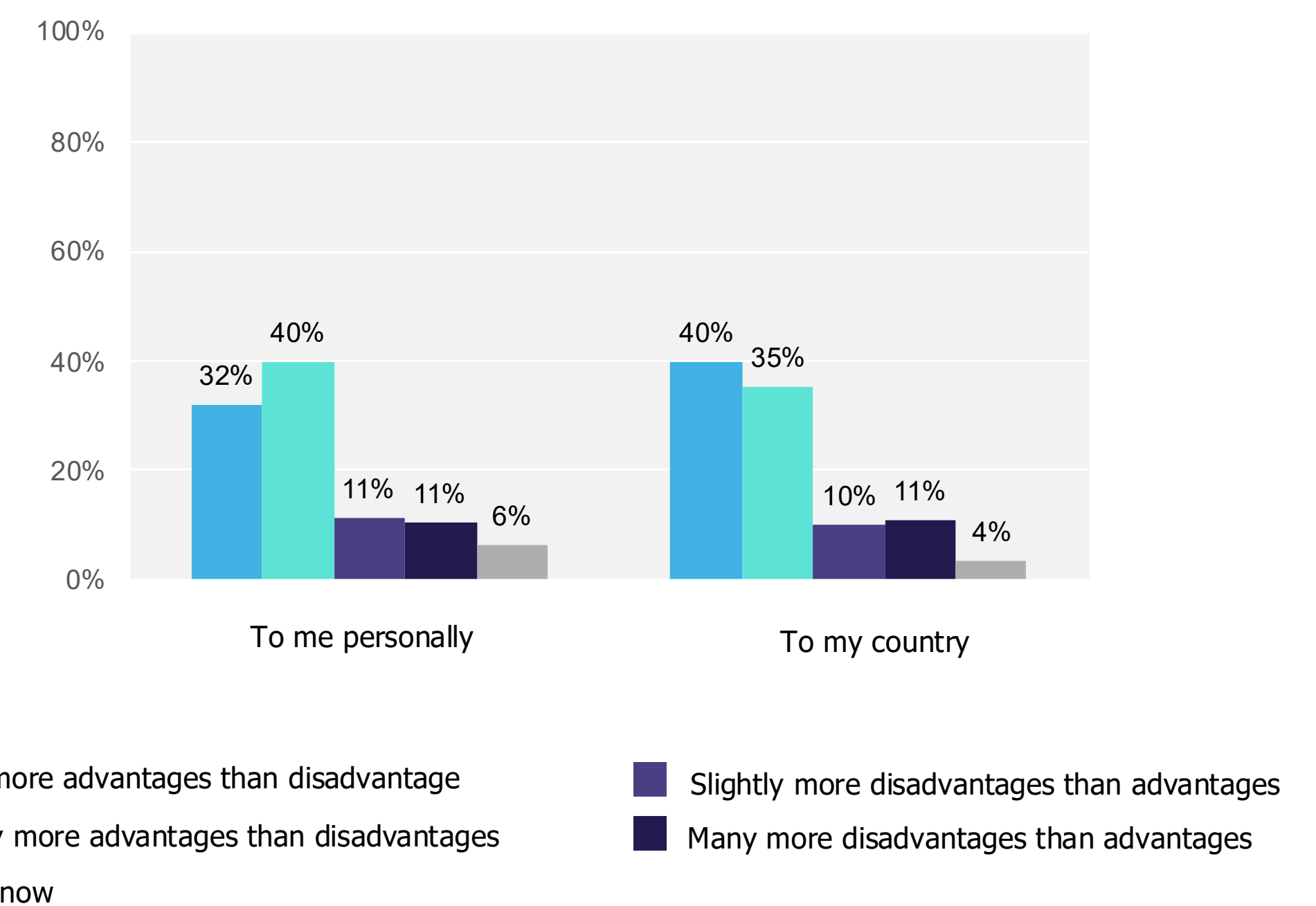

If a referendum about Montenegro's membership in the EU was held this week, how would you vote?

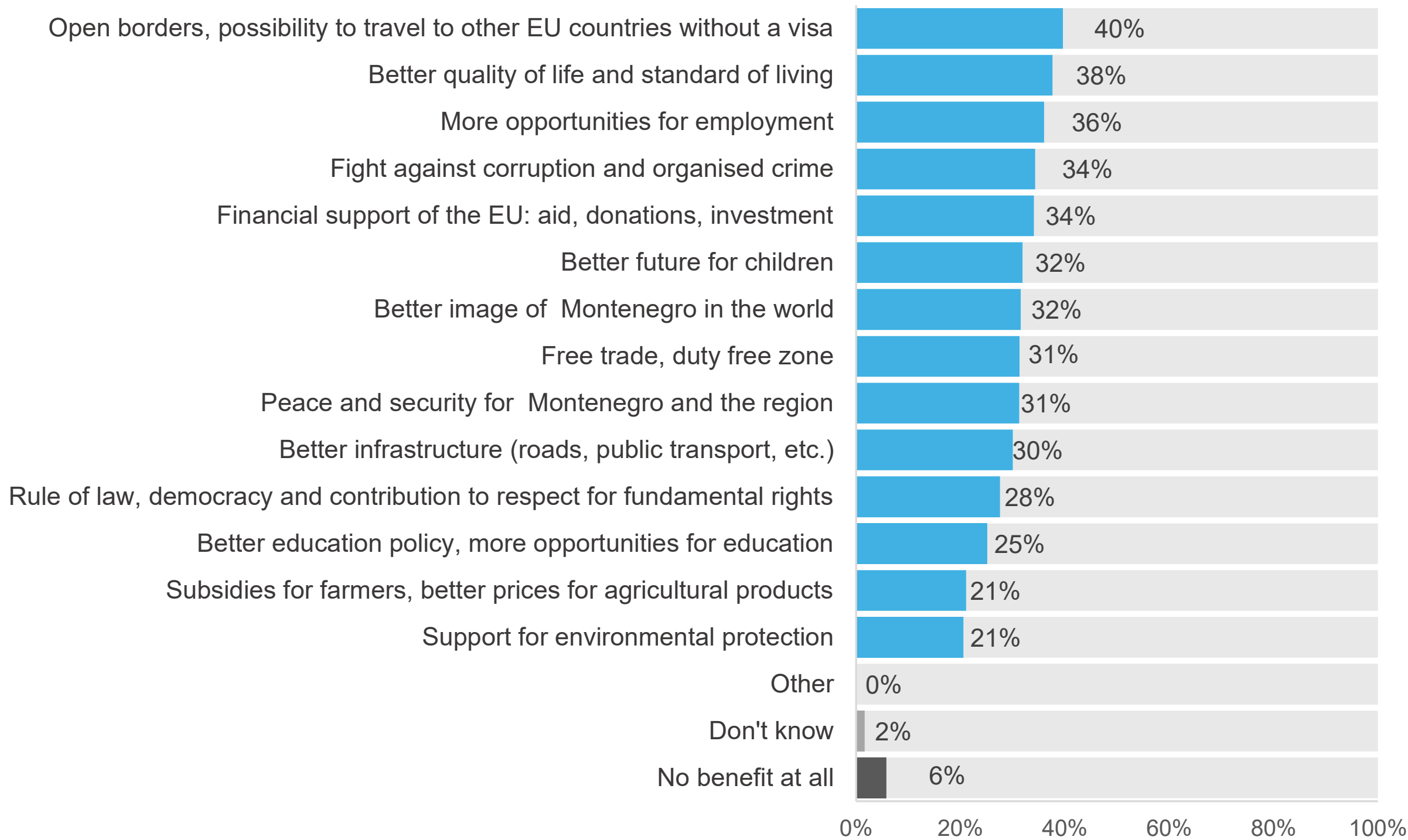


Would you say that becoming a member of the EU would bring more advantages or more disadvantages to you personally? And to Montenegro?

What do you think would be the main benefits of Montenegro becoming a member of the EU?



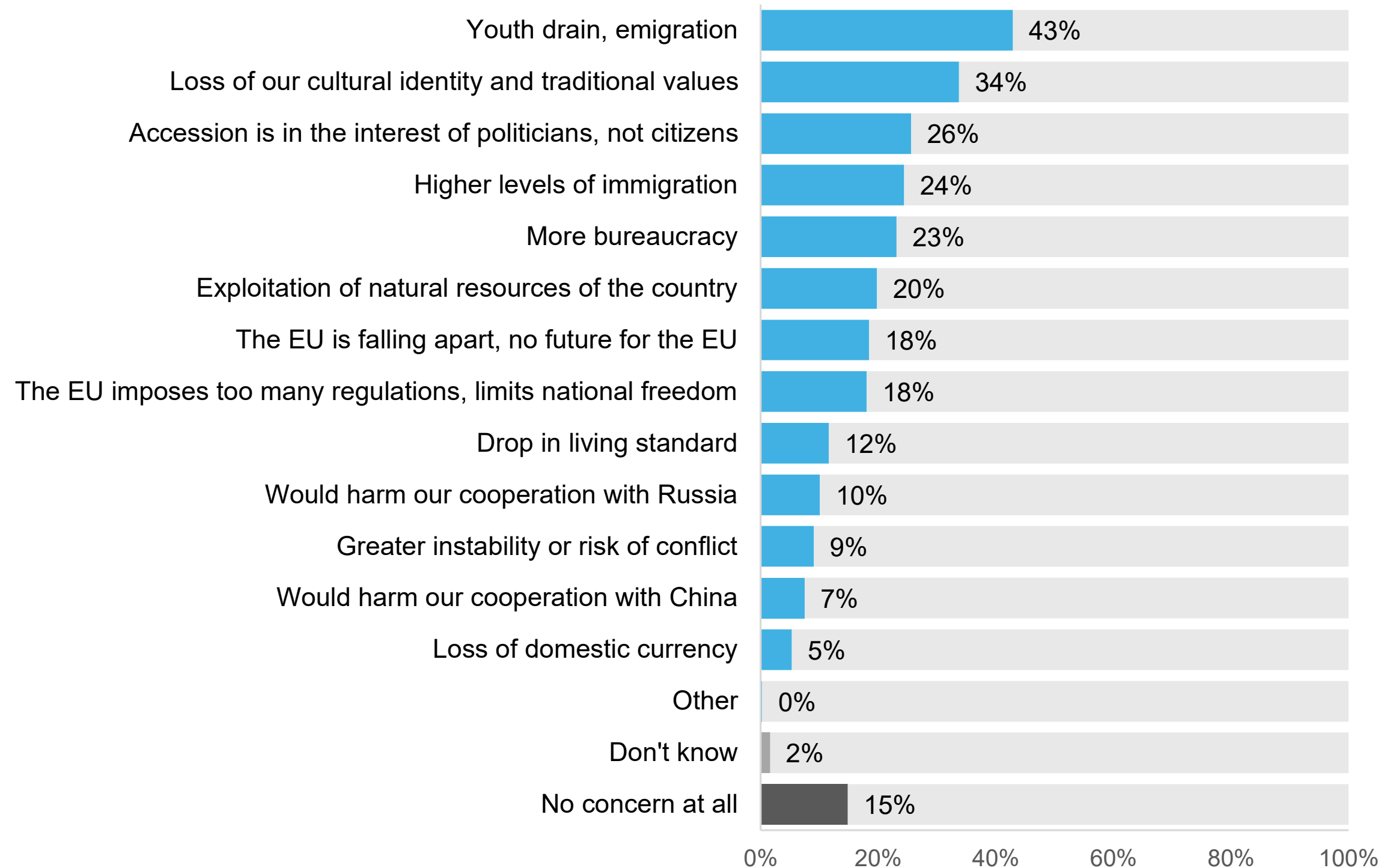
**Top perceived benefits of EU membership** *(respondents' first-choice responses):*

What do you think would be the main concerns of Montenegro becoming a member of the EU?



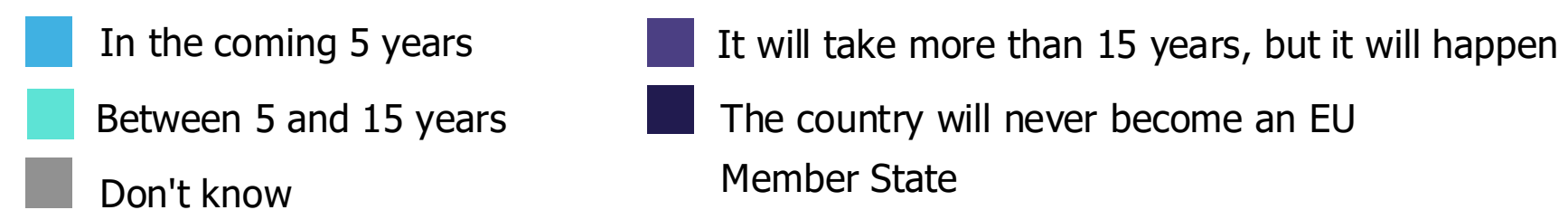
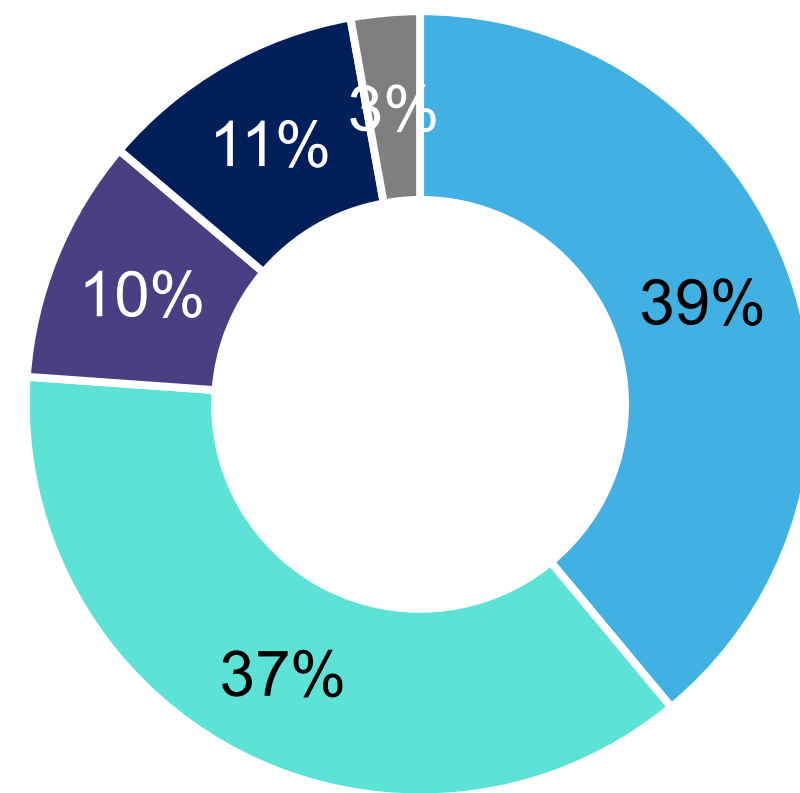
**Top perceived concerns of EU membership** (*respondents' first-choice responses*):

3. More bureaucracy (9%)

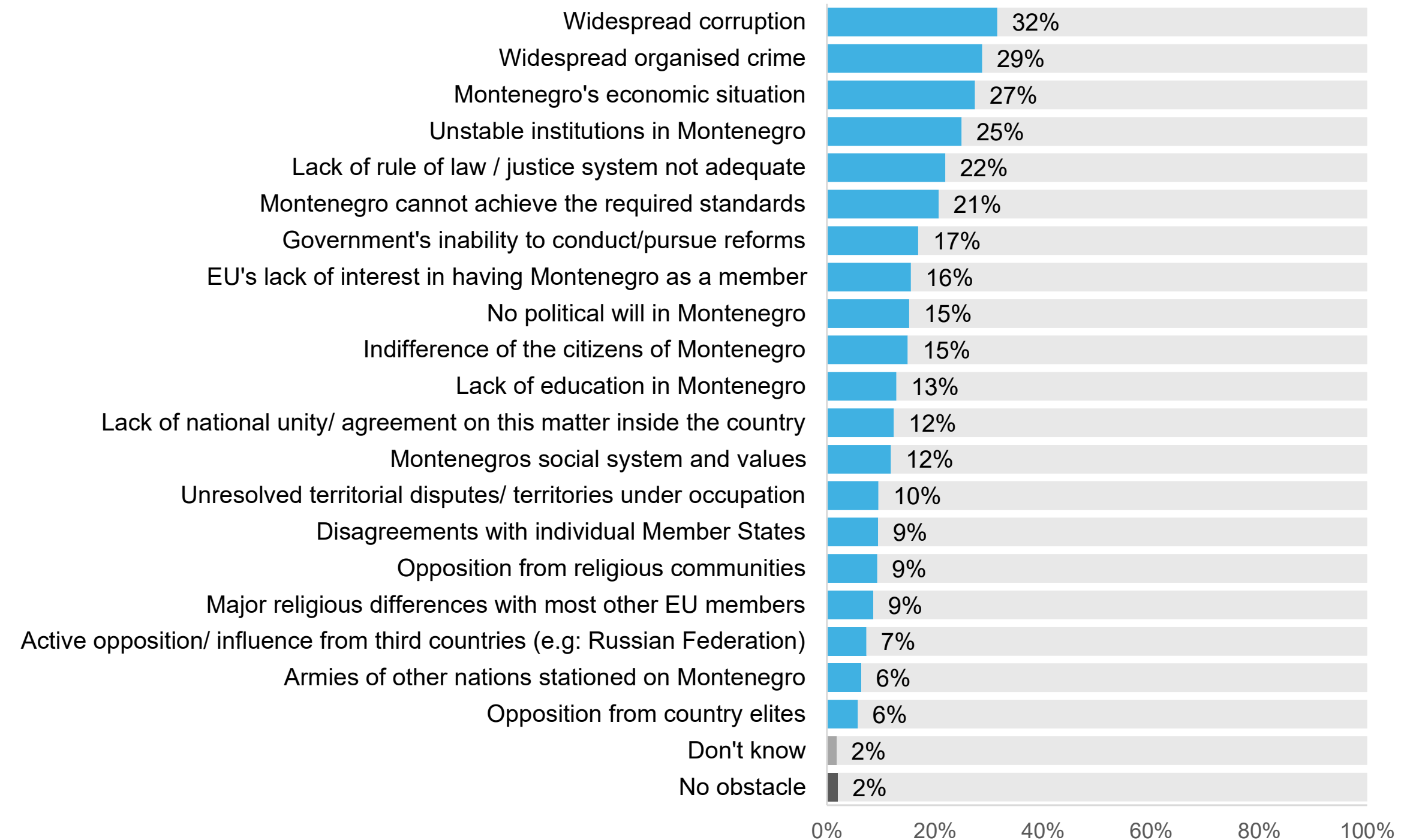

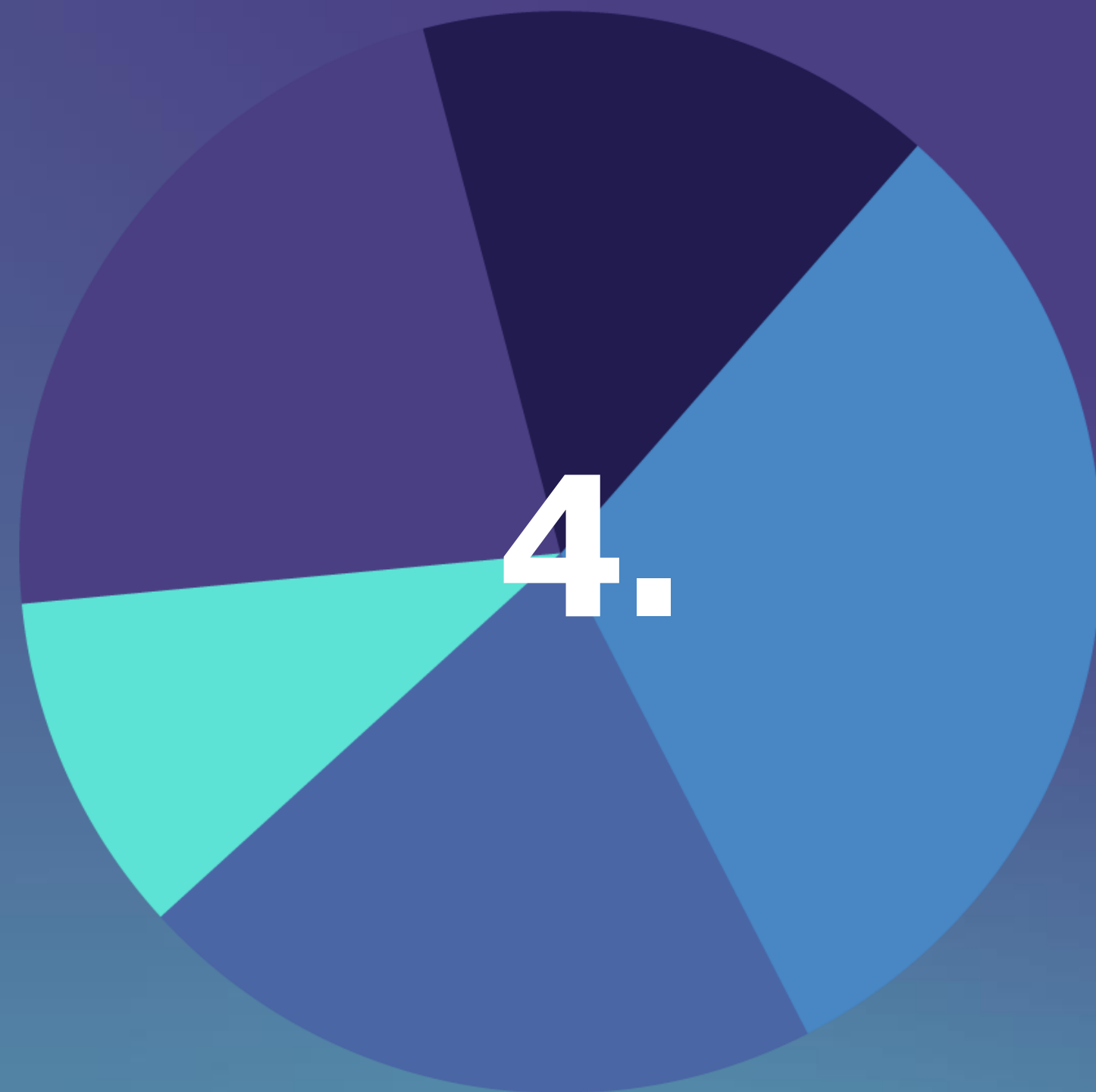
# Perceived timeline and barriers to EU accession

In your opinion, what are the main obstacles currently preventing Montenegro from becoming a member of the EU?





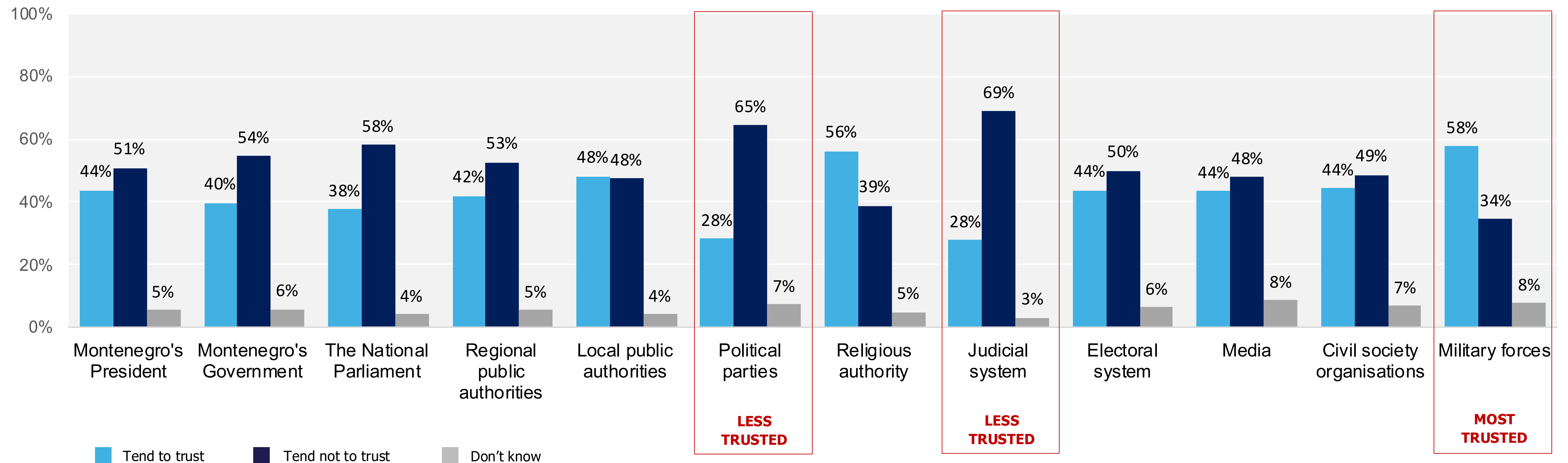

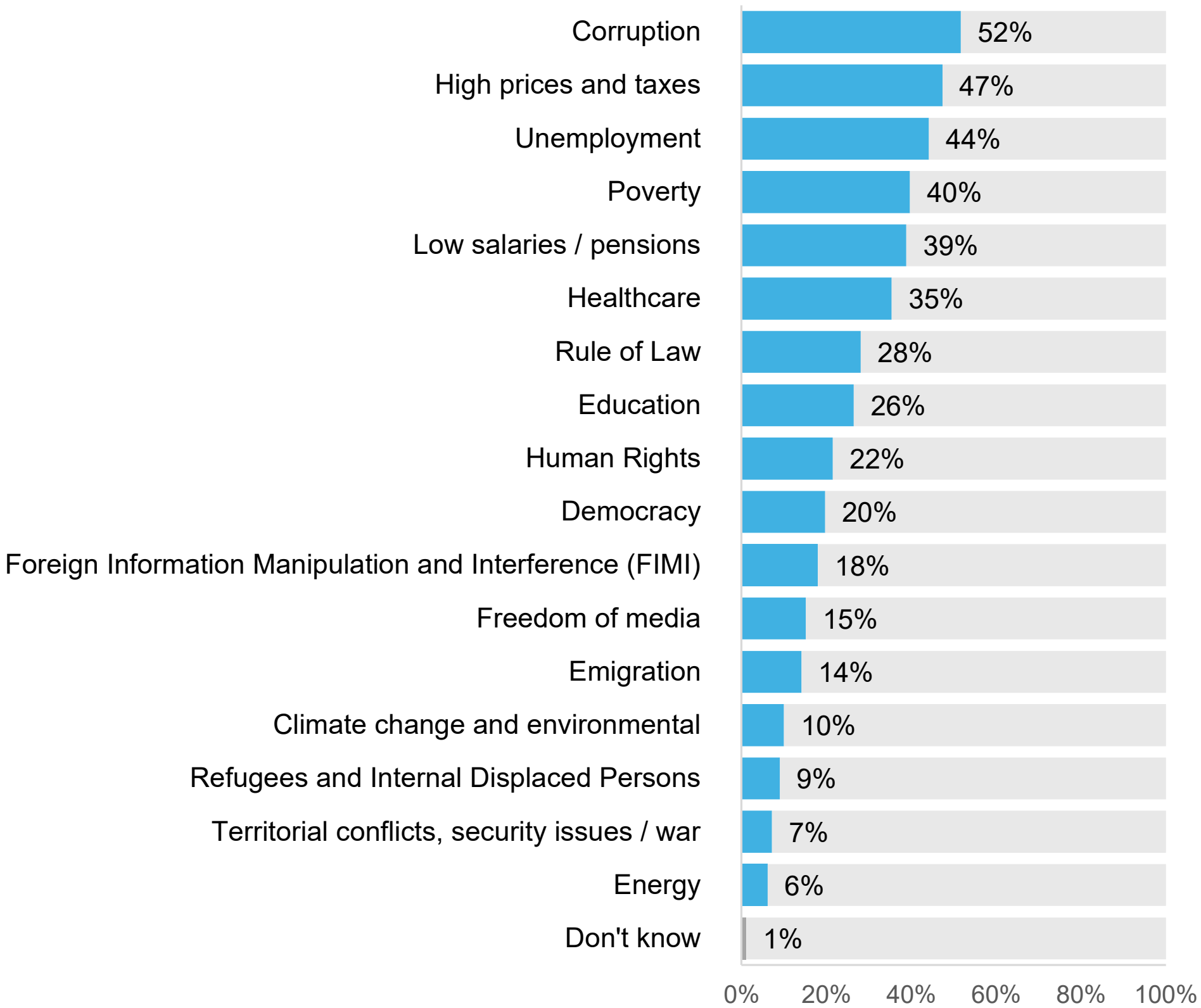
# Trust levels across key institutions and systems

Please tell us which is your level of trust for following institutions, organisations and systems



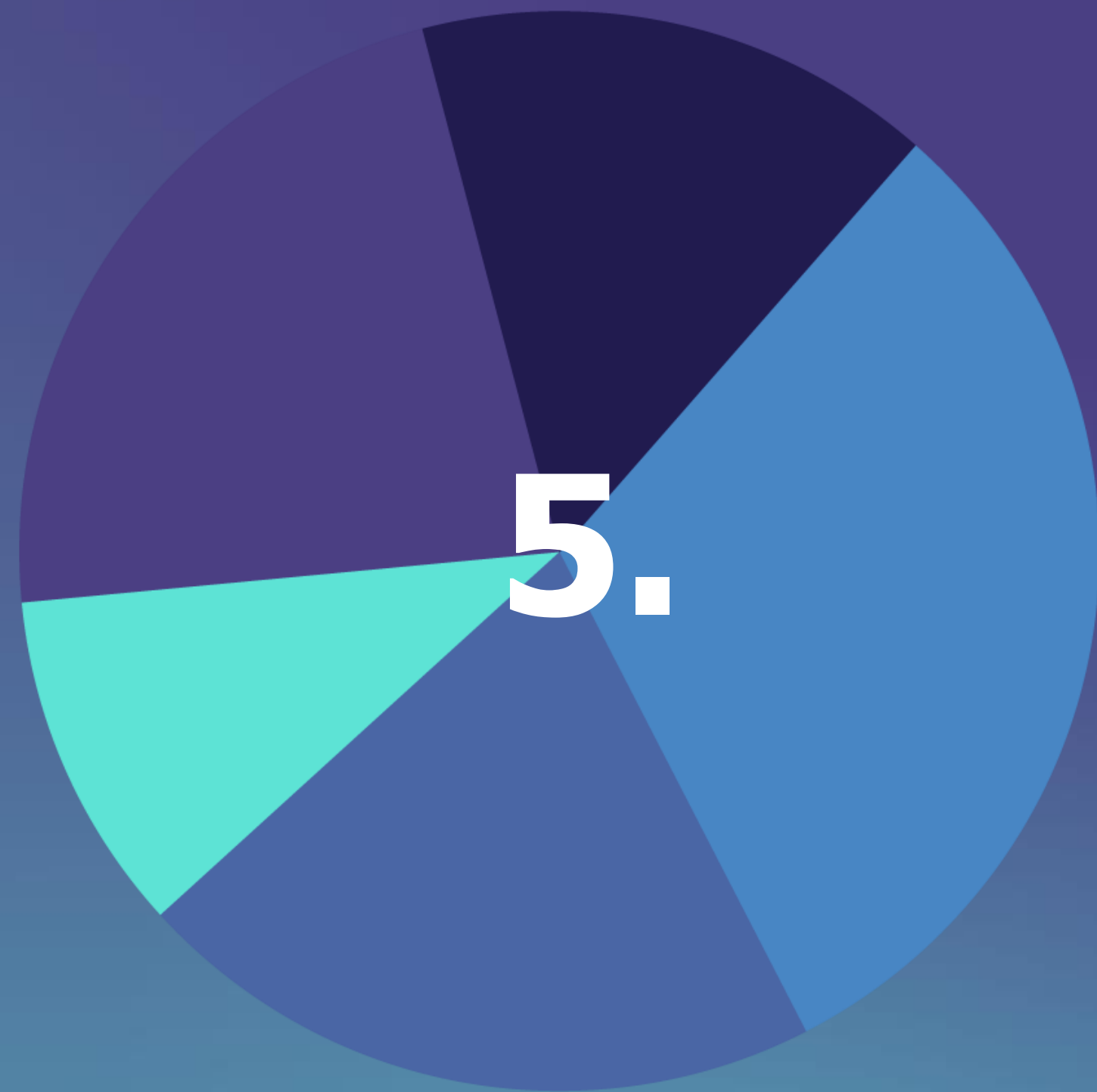
# Most pressing problems in MONTENEGRO

- Unemployment (9%)

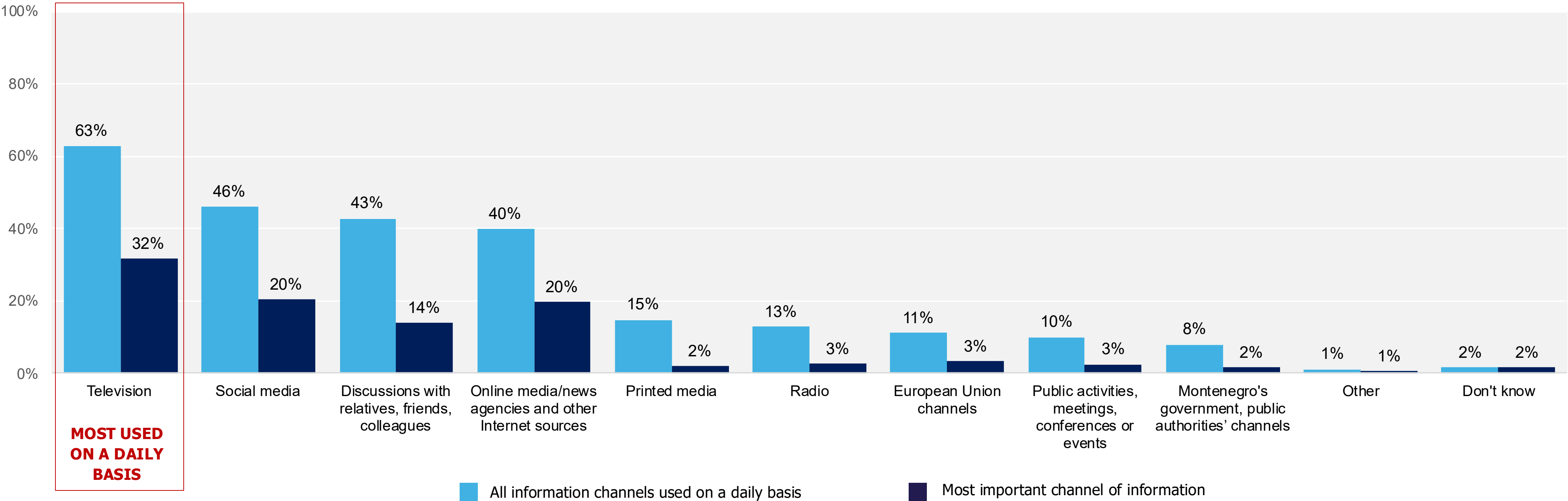
