### #EUandYOU

North Macedonia inaugurated the Kriva Palanka – Dlabochica – Stracin expressway, marking a significant leap in regional infrastructure. The €36.7 million project, **funded by the EU**, World Bank, and national sources, reduces travel time between Stracin and Kriva Palanka from 30 to just 10 minutes. Stretching 23 kilometres as part of Corridor VIII, the expressway connects Albania's Adriatic port of Durres to Bulgaria's Black Sea port of Varna.

Additionally, **the European Union in Albania** kicked off the year with a significant project aimed at supporting the country's EU accession. The **EU4Digital Justice** initiative, backed by €7.5 million, seeks to modernise Albania's justice system by digitising case management and enhancing the Information Technology Centre for the Justice System.


