#### #EUandYOU

On 19th September, <u>European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen</u> met with Western Balkan leaders in Brussels to advance the €6 billion Growth Plan, with the purpose to boost socio-economic convergence, reforms and EU accession. During the meeting, von der Leyen reiterated the EU's commitment to economic and political integration, affirming that "all six countries belong in

Europe." Progress on key reforms was discussed for the 6 billion funds from Reform & Growth Facility.

Earlier in September, Bosnia and Herzegovina celebrated a major infrastructure milestone with the <u>opening of the Herzegovina Bridge</u>. Spanning 1km across the Neretva River, this bridge and 11.7 km of new motorway enhance connectivity with Croatia and the EU. The project, funded by a €5 million EU grant and a €105 million loan from the European Investment Bank (EIB), is part of the EU's Global Gateway strategy to boost regional integration, improve safety, and stimulate trade, tourism, and cross-border cooperation.

This achievement also coincides with <u>five successful years of the European</u>

<u>Investment Bank operations</u> in Bosnia and Herzegovina, during which the EIB

Global has partnered with the EU Delegation in BiH and Brussels to support critical projects, driving faster economic development and better living conditions.




